How to read the visa sticker



- **1 Serial number** of the visa sticker (HRV + 9 digits, it can not be repeated)
- **2 Valid for**: "Schengenske države" (the visa is valid for: Schengen States)
- 3 The **beginning** of the **period of validity** of the visa (date)
- **4** The **end** of the **period of validity** of the visa (date)
- 5 Duration of stay, i.e. the number of days a person is allowed to stay in Schengen Area (from 1 to 90 days)
- 6 Type of visa: it can be type A (airport transit visa) or type C (short-term visa)
- 7 The serial number of the travel document in which the visa was issued
- 8 Number of entries: it can be 1 (one entry), 2 (two entries) or MULT (multiple entries)
- 9 The name of the city where the Croatian Embassy or Consulate that issued the visa is located
- 10 The date of issuing of the Schengen visa
- 11 Surname and name of the visa holder. In case the name is too long, it is shortened to fit the visa sticker
- 12 The cost of the visa application fee displayed in different currencies, depending on the place of issue
- 13 The purpose of visit. The purpose must correspond to the real purpose of the visit. It can be: Private visit (PRIVATNI POSJET), Business visit (POSLOVNI POSJET), Official (SLUŽBENO), Tourism (TURIZAM), Sports (SPORT), Cultural (KULTURA), Conference/Seminar (KONFERENCIJA/SEMINAR), Course (TEČAJ), Family member of CRO national (ČLAN OBITELJI DRŽAVLJANINA HR), Family member of the EEA citizen (ČLAN OBITELJI DRŽAVLJANINA EGP), Diplomatic visa (DIPLOMATSKA VIZA), Service visa (SLUŽBENA VIZA), Humanitarian reasons (HUMANITARNI RAZLOZI), Seaman in transit (POMORAC U TRANZITU), Airport transit (ZRAKOPLOVNI TRANZIT) etc.
- 14 2D barcode
- 15 Photo of the visa holder.
- 16 Machine readable zone (MRZ)
