# Chairs of excellence

he René Cassin Foundation – International Institute of Human Rights – is pleased to announce the 3rd edition of the "René Cassin Chairs of Excellence" program, called:

#### « Electoral processes, Rights and Freedoms »

Receiving a René Cassin Chair of Excellence means having the opportunity to spend six months in Strasbourg to work on a collaborative project related to the theme alongside other laureates and to participate in events organized by the local funding authorities.

It also allows you to develop a project, chosen by the Foundation for its relevance to the topic, by engaging with various local, associative, and European stakeholders in Strasbourg. Additionally, it provides the chance to work on a critical human rights issue with laureates from diverse backgrounds and a multidisciplinary approach.

In 2025, more than half of the world's population will be eligible to vote.

How can we guarantee fundamental rights during electoral periods?

What are the impacts of elections on fundamental rights?

# **PROCEDURE**

Your application must be submitted by November 30, 2024, at 11:59 PM (French time).

he candidate, regardless of their background or discipline, must present a proposal for a collective project to be carried out in Strasbourg with the other laureates.

The project will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- How the project relates to the theme?
- Feasibility of the project (management, budget, available resources, etc.)
- How innovative the project is in Strasbourg

Note: The Chairs of Excellence Program is solely intended to fund the collective project of the laureates to be carried out in Strasbourg. The Program does not aim to finance pre-existing or ongoing projects in the candidates' home countries.

Your application file must include, in addition to your presentation, at least two letters of recommendation from recognized figures in their field.

#### Location & Duration

Strasbourg (France) 6 months in person From June 1st, 2025 to December 1st, 2025

#### **Profile**

Student and/or professional No age or nationality restrictions

## Language

Proficiency in French and English, level B2.

## Fields of intervention

Political Science, Law, Economics, History, Geography, Philosophy, Sociology, Psychology, Linguistics, Music, Theater, Audiovisual Arts, Painting, Sculpture, Literature (nonexhaustive list).

Candidates selected for the final phase will be notified on January 6 and will present their project orally in a 15-minute videoconference.

# **SELECTION & JURY**

An International multidisciplinary jury will assess all applications. It will include prominent figures known for their commitment to the protection of rights and freedoms, and will be chaired by the Director of the René Cassin Foundation.

The jury will evaluate the relevance and quality of the proposed projects, paying special attention to their connections with initiatives developed at the local level in France (Strasbourg) by various stakeholders.
