#### **Tasks and responsibilities:**

Reporting to the Team Leader and under the supervision of the (Deputy) Fundamental Rights Officer, the main duties related to this position are:

- Contribute to the overall mandate of the Agency's independent Fundamental Rights Office to monitor, advice and provide training related to fundamental rights;
- Investigate cases related to fundamental rights stemming from complaints, serious incident and use of force reports;
- Monitor compliance with fundamental rights obligations at headquarter and in the field;
- Formulate recommendations to address identified shortcomings based on promising practices;
- Train Frontex' Standing Corps Officers on various aspects of fundamental rights.
