## ANNEX 3

## **SELECTION GRID**

If more than one consortium submits an expression of interest under this call, the Contracting Authority will proceed as follows.

During the opening and administrative check, the following elements will be assessed:

- Respect of the deadline. Expressions of interest received later than the deadline set will be automatically rejected.
- Eligibility of the applicant and partners according to the eligibility criteria set in Section 2.1.1 of the Guidelines.

If any of the requested information is missing or is incorrect, the Expression of interest may be rejected.

The Expressions of Interest that pass this check will be assessed according to to the selection criteria set in Section 2.1.3 of the Guidelines and will receive an overall score out of 50 detailed in the selection grid below.

The <u>selection criteria</u> are divided into headings and subheadings. Each subheading will be given a score between 1 and 5 as follows: 1 = very poor; 2 = poor; 3 = adequate; 4 = good; 5 = very good.

The final score will be a combination of global scores attributed to the expression of interest/applicant and, when applicable, of individual scores attributed to each member of the consortia proposed, based on the information provided in each individual expression of interest.

In particular; in the case of items 1.1, 1.3 and 2.2, an individual score will be attributed to each applicant/partner. The final score for those items will be the average of the individual scores received by each member of the consortium.

The other scores will be attributed globally for the consortium (items 1.2, 1.4 and 2.1) or solely for the lead applicant (item 1.5).
