WELCOME BACK!

The Congress Organising Committee has great news:

Last October, the XXX ISSCT CONGRESS was launched in a formal Ceremony at the location of the Sociedad Rural de Tucumán (Tucumán Rural Society), the Congress venue that is being remodeled especially for our event. Work is ongoing on refurbishment and our commitment to the Congress is assured.

During October we also saw the successful ATALAC-Tecnicaña Congress in Cali, Colombia. The President and the Secretary-Treasurer of the COC attended this event and promoted the Congress. They invited everybody to be part of a great Congress experience in Argentina.

We have continued to publish advertisements in popular sugar industry journals, guaranteeing that the Congress is promoted worldwide.

Important information for all delegates concerns the available flight routes into Tucumán. From March 2019, some of these will change, so delegates need to be aware of their options for travel to Tucumán.

SUNDAY 8 SEPTEMBER

Probably, there will be a tour through Quebrada de Humahuaca, World Heritage since 1994. Distance: 80km from Hotel in San Salvador de Jujuy. Destinations: Tilcara and Purmamarca.

- Transportation from Tucumán to the Post-Congress hotels and site visits will be provided by Congress Organising Committee.
- Hotels during Post-Congress Tour will be attributed by Congress Organising Committee.
- The Industrial Group will start after the Agricultural Group on Saturday 7 September because the delegates will be staying at a hotel in San Salvador de Jujuy City, located 110 km from Ledesma facilities.
- Dinner on Saturday 7 September will be hosted by Congress Organising Committee.
- Concerning the Agricultural Group a visit will be organised on Sunday 8 September to Chacra Experimental Station for delegates wishing to do so. Alternatively, other visits will be organised.
- Post-Congress Tour will end at about 3pm on Sunday 8 September. Delegates departing from Calilegua must take into consideration that the transfer to the airport will take around 90 minutes. For delegates staying in Jujuy the transfer time to the airport is 30 minutes.



THE CONGRESS THEME AND LOGO

The specially designed logo shows the main objective of our Congress: to contribute with new, significant knowledge to continue to improve sugarcane productivity and efficiency in manufacturing current products and also, to speed up development of new products applying innovative technology.

The 3 Xs clearly refer to the thirtieth occurrence of an ISSCT Congress. Leaning left, the three stalks contain the essential colours of sugar cane production: water, soil and biomass. Then, leaning right, three



leaves complete this concept showing their maturity cycle depicting plant growth in the crop cycle, starting with green on the left to yellow-dried leaves on the right, that represents the biomass used for energy production.

We've adopted the slogan "**Growing** *Energy.* **The Next Page**", highlighting the challenging steps for the industry to contribute to world development with different energy products - *including sugar energy as food,* for a growing world population and its continually increasing demand for food and energy. We believe that a long-term vision about this issue is a **must**. We are confident that with the huge potential of sugar cane, maximised by the effort of technicians, this Congress will give industries worldwide the ability to contribute with knowledge and ideas, developing new principles and processes towards a better and favourable future.

THE CONGRESS VENUE – OFFICIAL LAUNCHING CEREMONY



The Ceremony took place in Sociedad Rural de Tucumán (Tucumán Rural Society), the Congress venue that can host more than 1,500 scientists, technicians and business representatives from 80 countries. On this occasion, the sugar energy sector featured millers and arowers supporting this international event. The Governor of Tucumán, Dr Juan Manzur, proudly led the

ceremony and in his speech, he expressed some of his expectations: "This world Congress is an unprecedented event for the region. There's no doubt it will create many opportunities. Our history shows that once upon a time in 1816, Tucumán hosted the Declaration of Independence, whereby the Argentine Republic saw the light. Once more, Tucumán will host this Sugar Cane Congress; we are therefore expecting a technological and a productive leap for the better in northwest Argentina."





The facilities of Sociedad Rural de Tucumán aim to become the first Convention Center for the province. This is a great challenge for the Congress Organising Committee, but the remodeling has been designed to guarantee comfortable session rooms and a successful Trade Exhibition.



The following floor plan clearly shows all the services available during the event and their distribution over its 6,000 sq m. An ATM will also be available for cash

We remind all visitors who need a TOURIST VISA to enter Argentina, to register for the Congress and apply for the visa as soon as possible to avoid any inconvenience.

The following countries <u>DO NOT REQUIRE</u> a tourist visa to enter Argentina.

Andorra, Armenia, Australia, Austria, Barbados, Belarus, Belgium, Bolivia, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Colombia, Costa Rica, Croatia, Czech Republic, Chile, Cyprus, Denmark, Ecuador, El Salvador, Estonia, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Grenada, Guatemala, Guyana, Honduras, Hong Kong (With British Passport B.N.O.), Hong Kong (With Passport R.A.E.H.K.), Hungary, Ireland, Iceland, Israel, Italy, Jamaica, Japan, Kazakhstan, Korea Republic, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Malaysia, Malta, Mexico, Monaco, Montenegro, Nicaragua, Norway, New Zealand, Netherlands, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russian Federation, Saint Kitts and Nevis, San Marino, Santa Lucia, Saint Vincent and The Grenadines, Serbia, Singapore, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Suriname, Switzerland, Thailand, Trinidad and Tobago, Turkey, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United States of America, Uruguay, Vatican City State, Venezuela.
